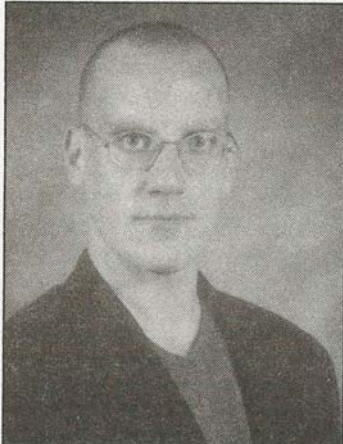

After graduating from UNLV with distinction in 1992, Justin Doucette went to work for the accounting firm of Deloitte Touche Tohmatsu. While there, he received the third highest score in the state on the Uniform CPA exam.



In 1995, Doucette left the accounting firm for the fast-paced and ultra-competitive restaurant industry; he joined chef Mark Miller's Coyote Café and Red Sage restaurants as head of business operations. Soon after, Doucette was offered partial ownership of the company, in which he is now a partner. He remains responsible for much of the company's business and marketing functions, and he will become one of the Nevada Restaurant Association's youngest chairmen when he takes over leadership of the trade group in 2003.

Doucette earned a master's degree from UNLV's graduate hotel program in 2000. He also recently established Justin Time Window Coverings and Justin Time Business and Tax Solutions. He is studying to obtain a Nevada real estate broker's license, and plans to enroll in UNLV's Boyd School of Law.

Doucette is vice-chairman of both the Nevada Restaurant Association and the Nevada Restaurant Self-Insured Group. He previously was treasurer of the Nevada branch of Habitat for Humanity.
